FIRED UP is a call to artists, both APBC members and non-members alike, for a small works exhibit of all mediums - 2 and 3-dimensional work - painting, photography, collage, mixed media, etc. We are pleased that pedestals will be available, so we encourage the submission of ceramics, sculptures, and other 3 dimensional works.

However, space is limited for this show so we are limiting the size of all pieces, 2 and 3D, to no larger than 20"x 20" (including frames).

No explicit sexual or political work is accepted.

Submission Deadline: Thursday, 2/1/24.

Notification to artists on or before Wednesday 2/7/24.

Hand delivery of artwork: Friday, 2/16/24, 11 am - 1 pm.

Opening reception: Saturday, February 17, 1- 3 pm

Closing Reception and Art Pickup: Saturday, 3/30/22, 1 - 4 pm. The closing reception will take place from 1 to 3 pm, and we ask that you wait until the end of the event to remove your work.

SUBMISSION FEES: \$25 for APBC Members, \$35 for Non-members. APBC Annual Membership is \$50, Signature membership is \$75, and VIP is \$100. 




DR. MARION ROBERTS

Warrior Dog: The True Story of a Navy SEAL and His Fearless Canine Partner (DB114541)

Reading time: 4 hours, 50 minutes GENRES: Biography; War and the Military; Animals and Wildlife "When Will Chesney became a Navy SEAL, he never imagined working with dogs. But when he was introduced to Cairo, a Belgian Malinois, they immediately became close. Will and Cairo started working together, side by side, depending on each other for survival in hundreds of critical operations. Soon their bond went beyond military service to true friendship. As Will moved on to other assignments, he saw Cairo less and less. Then, in 2011, the call came: Pick up your dog and get back to Virginia. Now, Cairo and Will trained for weeks, but it soon became clear that this was no ordinary mission. Cairo was among the first members of the US military on the ground in Pakistan as part of Operation Neptune Spear, which resulted in the successful elimination of Osama bin Laden. After the mission, Will went back to his job, until 2013, when a grenade blast left him severely injured. Now it was up to Cairo to save Will's life once more -- and then up to Will to be there when Cairo needed him the most."


